Annual General Meeting

The AGM was held at Stewartby United Church Hall on Thursday 22nd February. In his report the Chairman highlighted the events of the previous year and thanked members and



friends for their help at the sold-out concert in spring 2017, the annual dinner, the jumble sales, the concert - led by Shirley Hale - at Houghton Conquest Church and the November performance of Iolanthe.

In further remarks regarding Iolanthe the Chairman commented on the difficulties presented by the shortage of men auditioning and performing. He also thanked Stephen Hoath for standing in at short notice to play Strephon when Jessica Hallett was taken ill and wished Jessica good health for the future. The production of Iolanthe has been nominated for an award by NODA for the best musical in the region (more about this on page 2).

The Chairman concluded his report by thanking the committee for their support, in particular Hazel Daniels as Secretary for many years, and by announcing that he was standing down from the chair.

The Treasurer reported a net loss of approximately £2000 on Iolanthe. As he commented, although the Society's bank balance is still reasonably healthy, we cannot afford to continue making losses of this magnitude (Patience in 2016 made a similar loss). The Treasurer thanked the Society's patrons for their financial contributions and appealed for more people to become patrons.

In view of the Treasurer's report there followed discussion regarding membership fees which, by unanimous vote, were increased to £40 per year for Singing or Acting Members and to £10 per year for Associate Members.

Lady Skeet was confirmed as President and Prue Gardiner and Allan Thomas as vice presidents of the Society.


The members present approved the choice of The Pirates of Penzance as our production for November 2019.

selection of favourite opera treasures in support of the church restoration and to raise funds for the production of Don Giovanni later in the year.



Auditions will be on Sunday 27th May. In order to audition you must have attended at least two rehearsals and be a paid-up Associate or Singing or Acting Member.

Bedford Pantomime Company

Would you like to be involved in a fun show, bringing Christmas cheer to the people of Bedford and the surrounding areas?

We have auditions at the end of June for all parts, large or small, main cast and chorus. It doesn't matter what skill level or experience you have just a willingness to get involved, have fun and be committed. The show runs from the weekend before Christmas until the 1st of January at Bedford Corn Exchange, but not all days have a show, some days have one show and some have two.

The Bedford Pantomime Company have been putting on shows for 13 years, we give a portion of our profits to local children's charities and so far have raised over £20,000, the rest of the money goes in to running the next show, nobody gets paid we just do it for the fun and because we love it.

Rehearsals start in September, twice a week but not all cast are required for every rehearsal. We have an age limit for cast of 12 to 112 years old. There are two workshops before the auditions which we ask people to come to one or both to learn a simple dance, song and character lines. Auditions are inclusive, fun and relaxed, we just need to see willingness, who fits which parts and how everyone fits together.

If you would like to get involved then our workshops and auditions are on: Workshops – Sunday June 24th 2.00pm to 4.00pm & Thursday 28th 7.30pm to 9.00pm. Auditions – Sunday July 1st 2.00pm to 5.00pm.
